THIS WEEK'S LESSON: EXODUS



IN THE CAR: Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: This week we learned about how God did a miracle to save His people. He parted the Red Sea so they could walk across on dry land and escape from their enemies unharmed. It seemed unlikely to succeed, but nothing can stop God's plans. Exodus 14: 5-7, 10, 13-16, 21-27 – Parting of the Red Sea



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Share with your child a time that you made plans but they didn't turn out like you thought they would. Remind them that God was still in control.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Exodus 14:14 says, "God will fight for us. We just have to be still." Is it easy or hard for you to be still?
- The Israelites were afraid when the Egyptians were chasing after them? Do you think it's ok to be afraid? What should we do when we're afraid?
- What's a way God can fight for you this week?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Never stop reading this Book of the Law. Day and night you must think about what it says. Make sure you do everything written in it. Then things will go well with you. And you will have great success." Joshua 1:8 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

As adults we often want to make our own plans and then have God just come alongside our decisions. This focus in Exodus is a great reminder that God is in control. Things may not always go as we expect, but we can trust that He's got it.
